Pedagogical guidelines

Progress of IO4: The partnership has finished TASK 1 - Identify which technological means are currently available and how are they used. Each partner has delivered 5 different examples of the technologies both national and international.



The data is currently being processed for presentation. Virsabi developed a table of contents for the Pedagogical Guidelines which has been approved by the partnership. Furthermore, the first draft of the guidelines will undergo a peer review by the partnership in the upcoming weeks.



Guideline for online assessment

In the 1st phase (Analysis) of the DRinVET project, for Intellectual Output 6, EWF has completed two tasks within the six to be accomplished in order to fully develop IO6. The conclusion of this tasks resulted on the

alignment and compilation of relevant information for the IO6 guideline, regarding new procedures for harmonized assessment (both theoretical and practical training), through research on how online assessment is currently being performed in industry (profiles in Welding, supporting tools, resources, constrains and/or barriers, and topics – theoretical or practical contents or both).

🚊 Database for Digital Content

IO2 - VET library of DR (a database of digital content creators/ developers) is in its second month of implementation. IOS, partner responsible for this intellectual output, is currently creating a template for data entry



based on the input given by the partners. After agreeing on the final version of the form, IOS will proceed to setting up the database and partners will start collecting information based on the previously set search area distribution.

DISSEMINATION ACTIVITIES

Industrial and Trade School Slavonski Brod celebrated School Day and 75 years of existence on 15 October 2021. For this event, partners involved in this project organised a "Project corner" where the project poster was put on display and project leaflets were printed out for guests to take and make themselves familiar with project objectives and results. The School also designed and printed a Chronicle of the 75 years with a special section dedicated to all the projects the School has been involved in

Virsabi reached out to different educational institutions (such as Svendborg Erhverskole og Gymnasier or University College Nordjylland) and some companies which might be interested in the project.

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EWF has been coordinating the project dissemination through the development of the dissemination plan and report, as well as monitoring the dissemination activities and promoting activities to enhance the visibility of the project at European and local levels, including the development of dissemination tools in collaboration with all partners.

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LVE has reached 5302 people. The most valuable contacts were made in presentations and international conferences and educational progammes. These in person contacts were 410 of the 5000. The remaining, more than 4800, were from followeres and likes on social media.
